Instructions for accessing the 'Members Only' section of the website

You no longer need a new monthly password, but on the first occasion that you log onto the new system, you will have the opportunity to choose your own personal password, which you will then use each time that you log on. Only you will know this, and it need not change.

If you have not already logged on then follow this route:

- 1) Go to the Suffolk IVC website
- 2) Click on the Club Members area
- 3) Click on the grey area at the very top of the page LOG IN
- 4) In the first boxes that appears enter your user name, which is your e-mail address.
- 5) In the second box tick 'FORGOT PASSWORD' and you will receive an e mail with a password that you can use to get you in and you will then be able to change the password to something that you can remember.

Directions if possible (sometimes difficult as people will be coming from different directions) Parking Post Code Host Name(s) Contact Details (any that you wish to provide but there must be something)
