## Email events

Members can be notified of forthcoming events by email. This is particularly useful when an event is arranged at short notice. Any member of the group can notify the membership by using the **Message Members** menu option in www.cambsivc.org/eventadmin.

## Hosting Events

Members are required to host a minimum of 2 events, advertised in the bulletin in advance, per year to qualify for the 50% reduction in membership. The full list of events can be found on the on-line event management system: www.cambsivc.org/eventadmin. To get full details of events you will need the "Diary" password found at the top of this bulletin. We recommend you refer to the guidelines on hosting an event which can be found at www.cambsivc.org/eventadmin/hosting.php.

## To put your event in the Bulletin

To enter an event into the Events Diary, go to the Events Admin page: www.cambsivc.org/eventadmin and enter the Events Diary Password that appears at the top of this bulletin, which changes each month. The Events Admin page is also accessible by clicking on the "Event Diary" link on the bottom right of the Events page.

Click the "Add Event" button and fill in the form - remember details in the "Public" Description filed will also be made available to prospective New Members - so **DO NOT** put personal email, phone or address details in that field - use the "**Private**" contact details field.

To ensure your event makes it into Our Meetup Group (Cambridgeshire IVC - In Very good Company) simply click "Yes" in the appropriate box. If you need to change this at a later date simply email meetup@cambsivc.org.

When complete, click "Enter" to complete the entry. You will then receive an email with a web link and "**Event Code**" which are both unique to your event and allows you to amend or de-activate your event. Events listed in Events Diary will appear in the next bulletin. Please notify members of forthcoming events by email as well as adding your event to the diary. Send details of your event, including the date, time, type of event, event details and the organiser's name and contact details using the Message Members facility.

Events sent to all members using the messaging facility as above, generates an email to all members. Events entered into the Events Diary on the website or emailed to bulletin-editor@cambsivc.org are received by the Bulletin Editor only and go into the next version of the bulletin.
